Birds that arrive during early spring at Columbus Park

Columbus Park is on the west side of Chicago, just east of Oak Park.



Red-winged Blackbird (male)Sings at the edges of the lagoon and ponds.



Common Grackle

Looks for food on the ground.



Eastern PhoebeCatches flying insects, often near water.



Golden-crowned Kinglet
Catches small bugs on in trees and shrubs.



Northern Flicker
Laps up ants on the ground.



Swims on the lagoon and perches in trees.



Fox Sparrow *Lurks low on lawns and in wooded areas.*



Song SparrowIn the prairie and at edges of lagoon.



Swamp SparrowIn cattails and weeds near water's edge.
