These are some of the birds we've been seeing this winter in Columbus Park.



Canada Geese

Look on lawns when there's no snow.



Herring Gulls

On the lagoon ice or flying overhead.



Downy Woodpecker

Look on tree trunks and branches.



Red-tailed Hawk

Look in trees and flying overhead.



American Kestrel

Look in treetops and flying overhead.



Northern Cardinal

Look in bushes and small trees.



Rock Pigeon

Look on chimneys, roofs, and streets.



House Sparrow

Look around buildings and in bushes.



European Starling

Look in trees and on grass and wires.
